EU FUNDING SOURCES

EU's Framework Programme for Research and Innovation "Horizon 2020"

- ✓ managed by the European Commission (EC)
- ✓ budget of nearly € 80 billion for seven years (2014-2020)
- coupling research to innovation
- selection of projects based on regular open calls for proposals and international peer review
- majority of activities are of a multilateral, international character, each involving different actors from academia and industry
- open for participation by Russian entities, in partnership with European counterparts

RUSSIAN FUNDING SOURCES (2)

Federal Targeted Programme "R&D in Priority Areas of Development of the Russian S&T Complex 2014-2020" (FTP R&D)

✓ managed by the MON

- ✓ budget line 2.2 "Support for research in the context of cooperation with EU countries"
 - 6.18 billion Roubles (ca. € 125 million) for collaboration with the EU and EU Member States for the period 2014 2020
 up to a maximum of 50 million Roubles (ca. € 1 million) per project, for a period of up to 4 years

FUNDING SUPPORT FROM THE RUSSIAN MON

- ✓ FTP R&D calls under budget line 2.2 and other relevant budget lines
- ✓ open collaboration in Horizon 2020 in selected priority areas
- ✓ coordinated EU-Russia calls

Co-funding mechanisms: Procedures

N.B. All Horizon 2020 calls are open to Russian participants.

The following slides describe the procedures whereby funding for participation in Horizon 2020 projects may be provided by Russian national funding bodies <u>in those cases</u> <u>where</u> the Russian participant of a Horizon 2020 project proposal requires and requests such funding support.

FUNDING SUPPORT FROM THE RUSSIAN MON: PROCEDURE FOR COOPERATION IN HORIZON 2020 (3)

• The European Commission carries out its standard evaluation procedure of all Horizon 2020 project proposals, including those with Russian participants.

• The Russian funding party carries out its standard evaluation procedure of Russian proposals which are part of a submitted Horizon 2020 project proposal and which have been submitted to the given Russian funding body.

 After the EC evaluation under Horizon 2020 and the national evaluation in Russia, both sides exchange information about the evaluation results, including the list of proposals (with Russian participation) which may be funded.

FUNDING SUPPORT FROM THE RUSSIAN MON: PROCEDURE FOR COOPERATION IN HORIZON 2020 (5)

- ✓ In the case of two-stage evaluation procedure of the Horizon 2020 calls, the applications to the Russian finding body will be made at the second stage.
- Special arrangements can be made for a joint EU and Russia evaluation for Coordinated Calls, Joint Calls or Parallel Projects. If coordinated projects are to be implemented by two separate agreements (i.e. Russian participants do not sign the EU Grant Agreement), the Russian participants must submit their proposal to the MON together with a draft Coordination Agreement.
- ✓ EC and Russia will also support research cooperation through the participation of Russian funding bodies in the ERANET mechanisms within Horizon 2020.
- EU proposal evaluations are executed by international experts. Russian experts are encouraged to register in the expert pool.

FUNDING SUPPORT FROM THE RUSSIAN MON: PROCEDURE FOR COOPERATION IN HORIZON 2020 (6)

Project proposals that are eligible for support by the MON:

- Any legal entity registered in the Russian federation can apply for funding.
- ✓ Duration of the projects can be from 2 to 4 years, it is agreed before the call announcement, is fixed in the call documentation and cannot be changed.
- Requested funding from the MON per year has to be 50% or less than the whole funding of the project. The funding for each project per year is fixed in the submitted application and cannot be changed.
