A representative delegation from Harbin arrived to SPbPU

A representative delegation from Harbin Engineering University (HEE) headed by Yu Zhiwen, Vice-Rector for International Activities, visited Peter the Great St. Petersburg Polytechnic University. And if we talk about joint educational programs, we will be able to consider different schemes of cooperation, said Olga Emelyanova, Head of the Department of International Educational Programs and Academic Mobility.

During the visit the Chinese colleagues also got acquainted with the scientific and technical potential of the university. They visited the laboratories of the Higher

School of Cyberphysical Systems Management and the Supercomputer Center.
