## <u>SPbPU improved its position in QS World University Rankings:</u> <u>Sustainability 2025</u>

The British company Quacquarelli Symonds has published a sustainability ranking of the world's best universities. There are 1744 universities in the list. Peter the Great St. Petersburg Polytechnic University ranked 5th among Russian universities, and in the world ranking it is on the 693rd position.



When compiling the ranking, experts took into account three global parameters: environmental impact, social impact and management system. Compared to the similar ranking of the previous year, Polytechnic University has strengthened its sustainable development position in the field of education, as well as in terms of employment and career of graduates.
