## <u>SPbPU is among the five leaders in metallurgy in the URAP</u> <u>Ranking</u>

Scientific groups, teachers and students of SPbPU regularly publish the results of their work in leading scientific journals, because the assessment of academic excellence allows us to demonstrate the level of scientific and educational potential of the university. Despite the difficulties faced by Russian universities in terms of publication activity, we at SPbPU try to support our employees in their efforts to realize their scientific potential, and also support scientists from other universities by providing the opportunity to publish in the periodicals of our university," said Maria Vrublevskaya, Vice Rector for Personnel Policy.

It should be recalled that the university's positions in the Ranking by Academic Performance are also taken into account for the ranking of universities in the <u>Global aggregated ranking</u>, according to which SPbPU is among the top 3% of the best universities in the world.
