<u>SPbPU is the leader among St. Petersburg universities</u> <u>according to hh.ru</u>

In April the results of hh.ru ranking <u>«The Best Universities of Russia 2022-2023»</u>, became known, where Peter the Great St. Petersburg Polytechnic University took the first place among the universities of the Northern Capital and the fourth place among all Russian universities as the best university for training highly qualified personnel demanded in the national economy. It should be noted that only two St. Petersburg higher educational institutions out of 38 are in the top 10 of the Russian ranking (Polytech is ahead of St. Petersburg State University by four positions). In total, 411 Russian universities are represented in the 2023 ranking, which is 43 more than a year earlier.

- 1. Popularity of the university in its region
- 2. The employers' demand for the university graduates
- 3. The relative level of expected graduate salaries
- 4. Total length of employment
- 5. Current employability of graduates.

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
