

Regulation on awarding scholarships and other forms of material support for students of the federal state autonomous educational institution of higher education “Peter the Great St. Petersburg Polytechnic University” approved by order dated 10.07.2020 No. 1022

The regulation on awarding scholarships and other forms of material support for students enrolled in SPbPU programmes of higher education and secondary professional training establishes the rules for awarding and paying state academic scholarships to students and attendees of preparatory departments (foreign citizens and stateless persons) (including the requirements for students awarded with a state academic scholarship) and (or) state social scholarships to students, increased social scholarships to students enrolled in full time programmes at the expense of budget allocations from the federal budget, state scholarships to postgraduate students enrolled in full time programmes at the expense of budget allocations from the federal budget, as well as the criteria to be met by the achievements of students enrolled in full time programmes at the expense of budget allocations from the federal budget (Bachelor’s programmes, Specialist’s programmes, and postgraduate programmes) so that an increased state academic scholarship can be awarded and other forms of material support can be provided to those who study in the programmes of higher education and secondary professional training.

A scholarship is a cash payment awarded to students for stimulation purposes and (or) to support them while they master the educational programmes they have enrolled for.

The University awards the following types of scholarships:

- a state academic scholarship for students, including an increased state academic scholarship given to students for special achievements in learning, research, social, cultural and creative, or sport activities (hereinafter increased state academic scholarships);
- a state social scholarship, including an increased state social scholarship;
- a state scholarship for postgraduate students;
- scholarships of the President of the Russian Federation and of the Government of the Russian Federation;

- personal scholarships awarded by legal entities or natural persons;
- scholarships to foreign citizens admitted according to educational quotas for training foreign citizens on professional programmes of study in Russian – attendees of preparatory departments in cases envisaged by the Law on Education.

The University can establish other types of scholarships introduced by Regulations on such scholarships and not financed from the scholarship fund.

The amounts of state scholarships are established by an order of the Rector (or a person empowered by the Rector) based on the decision of the University Academic Council and given the opinion of the elective body of the Student Union of SPbPU as well as the financing capacities of the scholarship fund, but they cannot be less than the standards defined by the Russian Federation Government for each level of professional education and categories of students with due regard of inflation.

All types of scholarships are awarded by an order of the University Rector or by a person empowered by the Rector.

All types of scholarships and other payments are made monthly within the period from the 25th day of the current calendar month to the 5th day of the month following the one for which the payment is made provided that the relevant funding is in place.

The payment of all scholarships is terminated from the moment the student leaves the University. In this case the size of the scholarship paid for the month in which the leaving takes place is determined proportionally to the number of days from the first day of the month to the date of leaving.
