WHERE?

The glorious **St. Petersburg** – the second largest city in Russia and the fourth in Europe – is situated in the North-West of the country, next to the borders with Finland and Estonia. - creative thinking,
- idea generation and selection,
- investigating the market,
- business modelling skills for high tech projects,
- project team work and cross-cultural communication,
- presentation skills.

THE 2019 CURRICULUM TOPICS ARE DIVIDED INTO 3 PARTS:

- Technology Entrepreneurship (3 ECTS)
- Aspects of business planning and venture capital in Russia (1 ECTS)
- Seminars with entrepreneurs (1 ECTS)

Upon successful completion of the program the participants will receive a certificate issued by SPbPU.

WHY?
