

Dear students of INTRA-MUARL MODE OF STUDY!

Please see below how SPbPU international students can get a MIR plastic card:

- **If you are a holder of a Bank Saint Petersburg plastic card, please come to the office of this bank at #9 Toreza Ave, Monday through Friday, 11 a.m. – 7 p.m. (Metro station Ploshchad Muzhestva). This is the only dedicated office where you can apply for a MIR debit card!**

To do this, foreign citizens must bring to the bank office originals of the following documents:

1. Passport of a foreign citizen
 2. Notarized translation of the passport
 3. Migration card (obligatory for foreign citizens, with the exception of cases when the absence of a migration card is permitted by the RF Legislation)
 4. Document confirming the right of a foreign citizen to stay / reside in the Russian Federation (visa; residence permit; temporary residence permit; another document confirming the right of a foreign citizen to stay in the Russian Federation)
 5. Document confirming the registration of the client (the detachable part of the notification form on the arrival of a foreign citizen or stateless person at the place of stay with a note on registration with the migration register, or the Application of the foreign citizen about the place of residence (registration) or place of stay as a document allowing to record information about the address of the place of residence or place of stay).
- **If you already have a plastic card of any other Russian bank, you can apply for a MIR card through the online client service of your bank.**
